PAYMENT ~ TWO METHODS

1) **Register and pay online at www.deltaclippedwings.org.** After logging in, go to the EVENTS SECTION in the bottom right corner and click on "12/15/15 ~ REGISTER FOR "HOLIDAY LUNCH" to bring up the registration form. Your information will automatically populate the form. You can enter and pay for up to 5 guests with this online form! Submit the form and continue through the payment process. You will receive an email confirmation showing your credit card amount and the names for you and your guests ... VERY EASY and MODERN!!!

2) **Pay by CHECK.** Make checks payable to DELTA CLIPPED WINGS (your check is your reservation, so mail it early!). DO NOT SEND cash or a bank transfer. Please be sure your name, address and phone number is on the check and the name of anyone you may be paying for. Mail your check to **Delta Clipped Wings ~ Alva Blake, PO Box 724944, Atlanta, GA 31139-4944.**

Payment Deadline: Payment must be received by Monday, December 7th, so the final count can be given to the facility. DCW is responsible for paying for that number of guests whether they attend or not and while we want to remain flexible and sensitive to personal circumstances, please understand we are not always able to make refunds once the count is finalized.

Check-In/Arrival: Check-in begins at 10:30. **Please make every effort to arrive before 11:00 as the final number of attendees will be given to the kitchen at that time.**

Advanced Seating: If you would like to sit with friends, "advanced seating sign-up sheets" will be available at the Check-in table. This process not only helps friends find where their party is sitting, it also helps other members find available seating at a quick glance. Please be aware, if you put someone's name on your list and they no-show, it is your responsibility to remove their name from your table list. **Note: Name cards may be placed on your table; however, NO "RESERVED" SIGNS** please as members walking through looking for an open seat may think the whole table is taken.

It's that time of year again to thank our military and their families. Last year we had 17,000 visitors and you can help again this year by volunteering in the lounge and/or donating food for the lounge.

SIGN-UP: Email me at cathy@atlantafinehomes.com. Please provide your name (as it appears on your photo ID), your date(s) and shift(s) preferences. I will email you a confirmation.

PARKING PASSES: There won't be any passes this year; however, retirees may ride the bus over from the GO lot with their retiree badge.

DAY OF YOUR SHIFT: Once you have parked you will need to get your gate pass that will allow you access through the SECURITY CHECK POINT. All volunteers will need to check-in at BANK 4 at Delta's main level ticket counter. The monitor above the position will be labeled GATE PASS CHECK-IN. Be sure to tell the Agent you are volunteering in the military lounge and need to pick up a gate pass. You will need to show a photo ID to get your pass and again when you go through the check point. The Agents in the lobby have been briefed on these procedures; hopefully you should not have any problems, but if you do, please look for a Passenger Service Agent in their red coat.

PHOTO ID: The name(s) you email me must match the ID you are going to show to get through Security. Children without a photo ID may be escorted through with an adult.

FOOD DROP-OFF LOCATION: DELTA DASH located right before you enter lower level curbside area.

**** Please note, all food items must be wrapped, dated and marked with the donor's information, i.e., name and address. They welcome ANY and ALL food, especially homemade cookies and candy. You may also take your food directly to the lounge provided it will be allowed through security.**

Toys: Only small toys that will fit under the tree like matchbox cars or tiny dolls. Delta has plenty of coloring books.

Thank you in advance for helping to honor our Military during this holiday season. They have waited a long time to come home to their loved ones and this opportunity allows us to thank them for their sacrifices. Our time and donations may seem small, but if you can put a smile on one of their faces, that is huge!
