Assistance hotline eases stress for customers traveling with wheelchairs

Delta customers requesting wheelchair assistance when traveling now have a hotline to call for immediate support prior to, during and after their trip.

"Our customers let us know they wanted a direct connection for questions about transfers with a wheelchair," said Bill Lentsch, Senior Vice President - Airport Customer Service and Airline Operations. "We listened and began testing the wheelchair assistance hotline earlier this year. After a trial program in Atlanta, feedback proved this customer resource makes a meaningful impact, so we're rolling it out nationwide."

Customers requesting wheelchair assistance throughout the United States, Caribbean and Canada can call 1.800.984.8935 for support daily from 6am to 3am ET. The calls are answered by Delta's Baggage Operations Control Center in Augusta, GA, where Delta employees take immediate action, working with stations around the system to assist the customer.

"The Baggage Operations Control Center agents have been instrumental in the success of the hotline and are true professionals in dealing not just with our baggage claims, but now also our customers who've entrusted Delta to assist them with wheelchair transfers," Lentsch said.

The philosophy behind the wheelchair hotline and every investment Delta makes, Lentsch explained, is to make every flying experience a memorable one.

"Every customer should feel confident when taking to the skies with Delta," Lentsch said. "All 80,000 Delta employees are here to assist however we can."

This is just the latest example of the airline's commitment to introducing innovative solutions that help reduce stress throughout the travel experience, like RFID for bag tracking and more efficient security lines.

It's that time of year again! Time for all those holiday preparations including dozens of cookies, pecan or sweet potato pie and maybe a coconut cake where you actually grate the coconut from a real coconut (No???).

This time of year, brings back many memories of warm kitchens, traditional foods and Mama baking the coconut until the coir husk got soft enough to crack. Then it would be "milked," the coconut inside grated or shredded to make a "real" coconut cake. I think Mama was into coconut long before it became today's rage of coconut waters, foods and lotions. I also remember my skinned knuckles from grating all that coconut meat.

In the spirit of this season, I ran across this fruitcake recipe that was in my Mama's "stuff." I know fruitcakes are the butt of many jokes, but I think you'll like this recipe.

Yes, I know you can also use fruitcakes for doorstops, target practice and other useful things, but this recipe beats any, and all, I've ever cooked.

FRUITCAKE RECIPE



INGREDIENTS

1 cup of water 1 teaspoon baking
1 cup of sugar soda 1 teaspoon salt
4 large eggs 1 cup brown sugar
2 cups dried fruit Lemon juice

Nuts

One full bottle of your favorite whiskey (sample the whiskey to check for quality).

Take a large bowl. Check the whiskey again to be sure it's of the highest quality. Pour 1 level cup and drink. Repeat. Turn on the electric mixer; beat 1 cup of butter in a large fluffy bowl.

First, you MUST be logged in to access the online donation form.

- > Be sure to fill in the date where it asks ... DATE OF EVENT: MARCH 24, 2017.
- → Once submitted, the form is sent to Sandy Chinn so she can catalogue your items.
- > TAX RECEIPT for YOU: When you submit the form online, you as the "member/solicitor" will receive an email confirmation with ALL the necessary information for tax records.
- > PRINT TWO of the email confirmations: ONE for your TAX RECORDS and ONE to include with your donated item.
- > TAX RECEIPT for a BUSINESS: A suggestion ... since you will receive an email confirmation when you enter a business donation, you can print it and give it to the business for their records. Our email confirmation has all the information a business needs for their donation record filing.
