Payment Deadline: Payment must be received by Tuesday, April 11th, so the final count can be given to the facility. 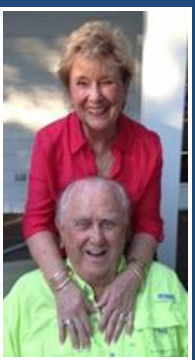
