## "SPIRIT OF FREEDOM:" MORE THAN AN AIRCRAFT; SYMBOL OF RESPECT

Five years ago, Delta dedicated one of its Boeing 757 aircraft to honor America's servicemen and women. The airline underscored that commitment to the U.S. military today, re-dedicating the plane with a fresh coat of paint and new logo during the first day of its annual Veterans Day event.

Known as the "Spirit of Freedom," the plane is more than an aircraft; it's a symbol of respect, said Delta's Veterans Business Resource Group vice president Kurt Robinson.

"This plane isn't your ordinary aircraft," he said. "When you see it pull up at the gate with the "Spirit of Freedom" emblem on the front, it's a reminder of how appreciative Delta is



of all service members and for all they've done for us."

The plane honors Delta's more than 10,000 employee veterans and 3,000 active duty employees - a commitment the airline takes seriously. When the plane was originally dedicated in 2012, the Secretary of Defense awarded Delta its highest honor given to employers, the Employer Support Freedom Award.

Delta's specialty liveries only grace a handful of aircraft in the airline's fleet, making this one all the more special. Originally, the aircraft's logo depicted the "Spirit of Freedom" text along with an American flag. Now emblazoned with the updated logo, the aircraft depicts logos of each U.S. military branch beneath the text.

Robinson, who is a veteran of the U.S. Air Force, explained that multiple Delta groups came together to get the plane ready for its big unveiling.

"Several people submitted concept drawings of the new logo, and then we worked with Marketing to make it come to life," he said. "We painted the plane offsite to keep it a surprise, and snuck it back in for TechOps to apply the logo." After TechOps' Veteran's Day observance, the plane will return to its regular schedule - flying to a number of domestic destinations across the U.S.

Update from Paula Saporito Knight's husband, Chuck (12/14): Unfortunately, Paula's battle with cancer has taken a new turn. A few days before we left for MD Anderson in Houston, she mentioned she felt a lump on the right side of her neck that concerned her. On December 12<sup>th</sup> she had an MRI and Pet Scan, part of her ongoing three-month monitoring, and they confirmed her suspicions. Unfortunately, the cancer is now in one of her lymph nodes in her neck. The major concern is this new tumor has appeared just three months after completing treatment of her mouth and lower nose. The good news is there is no other cancer currently seen. The bad news is this new tumor has come.

about in only three months. The second cancer came about 10 years after the first, the third 2 years later, and now the fourth, after only 3 months. The cancer is becoming much more aggressive.

The treatment this time will be a neck dissection on January 10<sup>th</sup>, at MD Anderson. This is a fairly simple operation with only one night in the hospital followed by 4 to 7 days before returning to Scottsdale. The tumor will be examined for molecular markers and other information to see if any clinical trials are available. Paula's oncologist said there are many studies being done at MD Anderson and at Emory Clinic in Atlanta. We will cross that bridge when we come to it. Right now, we are not looking too far past the surgery in January. Please keep Paula in your thoughts and prayers.

### FEDEX SCAM

There's a FedEx Holiday Email Scam Going Around. Here's How to Protect Yourself By Aric Jenkins - http://time.com/money/5073319/fedex-email-holiday-scam/ | Published 12-20-17

A seasonal email scam threatens to sour the holidays for a number of FedEx customers.

The fraudulent emails contain a subject line that reads: "FedEx: Delivery Problems Notification." Any emails with that subject line should be discarded immediately, CBS affiliate WTOL 12 reports.

FedEx is warning customers that the scam is designed to trick last-minute holiday shoppers, according to WTOL. The emails ask recipients to open an attachment in order to view an invoice or airbill required to pick up the package, but the attachment may actually contain a virus.

"The frequency of this email tends to increase close to the holiday season, presumably to exploit the growth in shipping volumes," FedEx says on its

Speaking of FedEx, did you know about the "FedEx Airline Employee Personal Shipping" program? Delta retirees and active employees are given a 75% reduced rate for shipping personal items.

Shipments must be dropped off at any FedEx manned location to a FedEx employee, during working hours. Please remember, you MUST show them your Delta retiree badge or Delta active employee ID as they will not just accept your word you are a retiree/employee.
