MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

- ✦ 30- & 7-day automated dues renewal notices are scheduled to be sent to those who have not renewed.
- ✦ After October 31st, the "You have been bumped" notices will automatically be sent to those who did not renew. If you receive one of these emails, you will no longer receive correspondence from us.
- ✦ Because of the date-based system we use for dues reminders, NEW members who join BEFORE October 31st will have a 2018 expiration date on their email confirmation. That will be corrected by us to 2019 or beyond if they joined for multiple years.

MEMBERSHIP FORM: The attached paper membership form at the end of this newsletter is the last one we will send out this year. Going forward you can print one from our website. **Note:** You don't have to log in to print a membership form. The form is found on the HOME page in the navigation pane at the top under "Membership Form."

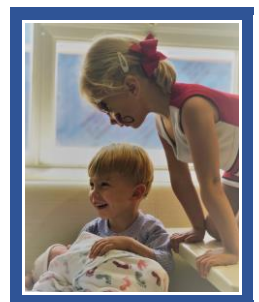

DELTA CERTIFIED AS A "GREAT PLACE TO WORK" FOR THIRD YEAR IN ROW

Delta was certified once again as a great workplace by the independent analysts at GREAT PLACE TO WORK. The airline earned this credential for a third straight year based on extensive ratings provided by Delta people in anonymous surveys.

The survey, sent to a random selection of Delta's more than 80,000 people worldwide, was anchored by 90 percent of respondents saying Delta overall is a great place to work. The analysis also shows 93 percent of employees are proud to tell others they work for Delta and 92 percent say they want to work at the company for a long time.

"As a recent arrival to Delta myself, I can attest to its remarkable culture," said Jennifer Carpenter, V.P. - Global Talent Acquisition. "It's wonderful to see the 'Delta Difference' validated by another year of GREAT PLACE TO WORK certification. Delta Air Lines, Inc. employees completed 1443 surveys, resulting in a 90 percent confidence level and a margin of error of ± 2.15.

The distinction joins a crowded shelf of prior honors from the company, including the most recent as one of FORTUNE'S 100 BEST COMPANIES TO WORK FOR 2018 (#98), and 2017 awards for BEST WORKPLACES FOR DIVERSITY (#15), BEST WORKPLACES FOR WOMEN (#10), and BEST LARGE WORKPLACES IN SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA (#15).



HEADLINE: DELTA FLEW A RECORD NUMBER OF CUSTOMERS THIS SUMMER | Between May 24th and September 3rd, Delta flew nearly 60 million customers, including the airline's new record customer enplanement day on July 26th when nearly 662,000 flyers took to the skies on a single day. Nine of Delta's top 10 busiest days by customers carried happened this summer and the airline flew on average 80 more peak-day departures versus the same period last year.
