PAYMENT ~ TWO METHODS

1) Pay ONLINE at www.deltaclippedwings.org. On the HOME page, scroll to the EVENTS section in the bottom right corner to "Friday, March 22 ~ **REGISTER for LUNCH** FOR "ANNUAL FUNDRAISER." Click on "**REGISTER**," then log in to proceed to the registration form. **IMPORTANT: For this event only, we are offering reservations for "TABLES FOR 10" ... see article below.**

Note from Bettie: A special thanks to all who have been using MemberClicks to make your reservation.

It's not only easy, but it also helps our Treasurer and CPA with their bookkeeping duties.

2) Pay by CHECK. Make your check payable to DELTA CLIPPED WINGS. Please DO NOT SEND cash or a bank transfer. Please be sure your name, address and phone number are on the check as well as the name of anyone you may be paying for. Mail checks to **Bettie Asip, 7740 Little Aston Way, Duluth, GA 30097**. Your check is your reservation, so mail it **early!!**

NOTE: Please allow 3-4 days for mailed checks to reach her.

Payment Deadline: Online payment and/or checks must be received by Thursday, March 14th, so the final count may be given to the facility.

If you call Bettie, please leave a message with your name and number, otherwise she will take it as a scam call and block the number.

Check-In/Arrival: Check-in begins at 10:00; we ask you to please make every effort to arrive before 11:00.

Parking: Free in designated parking area. **Be sure to pick up a parking voucher when you check-in.**

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you use valet parking, it is at your expense.

Dress Code: Business Casual

NOTE: We recommend registering for both the luncheon and GiveSmart at the same time, so you won't forget!!! See registration details for GiveSmart starting page 3.



DIRECTIONS TO ATLANTA AIRPORT MARRIOTT



Option 1) Get directions on our website - www.deltaclippedwings.org - by clicking on the red **Atlanta Airport Marriott** under the EVENTS section which will take you to Google Maps with the hotel's address already typed-in. Once on that website, simply type in your home address.

Option 2) If you have a GPS in your car or on your cellphone, you can obtain directions that way.

HOW TO RESERVE A TABLE FOR 10

An attendee (aka "Table Sponsor") may register/pay for a table of 10 for this event. **NOTE: The Table Sponsor must have an email address.**

Tables of 10 will be assigned a table number **PRIOR** to the event. Preprinted assignment sheets will be located adjacent to the check-in table. **NOTE:** It is important for the Table Sponsor to advise all persons in their party to look for the preprinted roster and not try to sign-up for another table.

TABLE SPONSOR DUTIES

- ❶ PAY \$390 for the entire table ... you are responsible for collecting payment from your guests.
- ❷ NAMES: List first and last names for each guest.
- ❸ MEAL CHOICE: List meal choice for each guest ... regular or vegetarian.
- ❹ EMAIL CONFIRMATION will be sent to the Table Sponsor listing all guests and their meal choices.
- ❺ NO SHOWS: Advise the check-in table if you have someone cancel at the last minute and be sure to cross off that person's name from the preprinted list.

ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR 10

- ❶ IF YOU ARE SITTING AT THE TABLE, list only 9 guests since you are the 10th person.
- ❷ TO REGISTER 10 GUESTS (**not including yourself**) go to the MEMBER MEAL CHOICE selection box on the online form and select **NO MEAL - GUEST REGISTRATION ONLY** so you won't be charged for a meal for yourself.
- ❸ MEAL CHOICE for each guest must be indicated to complete the online registration.
- ❹ ONLINE REFUNDS may be made if a guest cancels by MARCH 15th. Contact Bettie Asip to process the refund: (770) 813.9852 • basip@att.net.

CHECK REGISTRATION FOR 10

- ❶ MAIL **one check** for \$390, payable to DELTA CLIPPED WINGS, to **Bettie Asip, 7740 Little Aston Way, Duluth, GA 30097**. Your check is your reservation, so mail it **early!!**
- ❷ EMAIL CONFIRMATION: The Table Sponsor will receive an email confirmation once Bettie "takes the form" online.

Table assignments for groups less than 10 will be processed the same way we have done in the past ... you will sign-up for a table after you check-in.

Jo Kelly and Stacy Martin will be at the sign-up table if you need assistance.

Be sure to carefully read all the details in this newsletter as we are, once again, using GiveSmart mobile bidding. The information below will provide you step-by-step details to make your lunch reservation and pre-register your handheld device with GiveSmart so you will be ready to start bidding shortly after arriving at the luncheon.

Again, please keep in mind this is a fundraising event for our charities so bring your cash, credit cards and/or checks!!

To access the GiveSmart (GS) website, so you can bid on March 22nd, we recommend pre-registering with GS the same day you register online for the fundraiser/luncheon. **If you choose not to register at that time, or if you send a check to Bettie for your luncheon reservation, we have included the steps to register below.**



ONLINE PROCESS FOR REGISTERING FOR GIVESMART AT THE SAME TIME YOU REGISTER FOR LUNCH

NOTE: It is recommended you use GOOGLE CHROME as your browser

1. After registering for lunch, click on the "continue" button at the bottom of the page; this will take you back to our DCW Home page.
2. Under the **EVENTS** section, click on **REGISTER for GiveSmart mobile bidding**.
3. Log in again; then click on ... **CLICK here to register your mobile bidding account with GiveSmart** ... it will take you directly to our GiveSmart Home page.
4. On the Home screen, tap/click on the blue "Sign-In or Register" box in the upper right corner.
5. On the next screen, fill-in requested information and create a username and password.

**** Once you have registered for GiveSmart, you may want to go ahead and register your credit card at the same time so you will be ready to *rock & roll* on bidding once you sign-in at the fundraiser. ****

ONLINE PROCESS FOR REGISTERING A CREDIT CARD from GiveSmart Home page

On the Home screen >>>		Tap/click on MY INFO . You will then see your name, phone number and Add Card On File
After tapping / clicking on Add Card On File You will see >>>		Simply enter all the information asked for, then tap/click on Add Card and VOILÀ you will be ready to start bidding on March 22 nd .

NOTE: After you have completed your GS registration, you will receive a confirmation email and/or text message from GiveSmart ... SAVE THIS INFORMATION on your phone or tablet.

If you registered for the fundraiser luncheon online, but not for GiveSmart at that time OR if you send Bettie a check for your luncheon, here is the ONLINE PROCESS FOR REGISTERING WITH GIVESMART

1. Return to our DCW website and click on **REGISTER for GiveSmart mobile bidding** OR go to <https://deltawings.givesmart.com>
2. On the Home screen, tap/click on the blue "Sign-In or Register" box in the upper right corner
3. On the next screen, choose "Register Now" at the bottom of the screen. Fill-in all requested information and create a username and password
4. Next, check the box that starts with ... "I have read and agree to the terms ..."; then tap/click on grey box "Create my GiveSmart account."

As noted above, once you have registered with GiveSmart you may want to also register your credit card ... see "How to Steps" above.

NOTE: If you chose not to pre-register with GiveSmart prior to the event **OR** if you don't have a smartphone (android/iPhone) or tablet, representatives will be on hand at the fundraiser to help you register so you can bid on items. This may be done after checking-in to get your name tag and table assignment. **OR** if you don't have/want to use a personal handheld device to bid, there will be plenty of bid assistants to put in your bids for you.

What to expect after registering with GiveSmart

You will receive a confirmation email and text message from GiveSmart containing a link **specific to your account**. **SAVE THIS INFORMATION** on your phone or tablet.

HINT: Be sure to fully charge your devices before arriving at the fundraiser as bidding will only be done on your smartphone or tablet and you don't want to run low on power.

We have heard from several people who think they can bid from home if they are pre-registered with the GiveSmart website ... **THIS IS NOT THE CASE!!** While the bid items are available for preview once you have pre-registered with GiveSmart, **the same policy for bidding this year, is the same as it was in previous years - YOU MUST HAVE A LUNCH RESERVATION and SIGN-IN FOR THE EVENT ON MARCH 22nd to get your name tag, table assignment and start bidding.**

Why you should PRE-REGISTER and USE GiveSmart Mobile Bidding

Note: All credit card info is deleted from GS after our fundraiser is over.

- Once bids have closed, you may choose to use the credit card you will have on file with GS or pay by check or cash. **NOTE:** Nothing is charged to your card without authorization by you after you find out you have successfully bid on an item.
- You can **AVOID** check-out lines by authorizing payment as soon as the bids are closed. You will receive a text message of your winnings.
- You may pick up your winnings by showing your authorized bid winnings listed on your smartphone/tablet.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If you successfully bid on an item, but leave without picking up your item, **please be aware** we **will not** personally deliver it to you OR pack and ship it to you as this is an expense we cannot absorb. If this happens, we will simply refund your money and put that item up for bid at the April luncheon.

Raffle Tickets

Raffle tickets may be purchased with cash or check **ONLY**. One ticket is \$5; three tickets are \$10. **REMEMBER:** If you don't buy at least one raffle ticket, you won't be entered in the drawing for the **GRAND PRIZE** or **SECOND PRIZE**.

SUGGESTION: Bring address labels with you to put on the back of your raffle tickets so you don't have to write your name on each one; it also makes it much easier to read your name during the raffle.

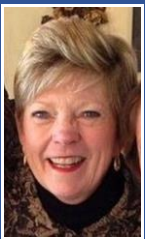
